

# Raceway Park

## 2012 Late Model Tire Program

(Raceway Park NASCAR Events Only)

- 1) F40 may only be used on the left side. / F50 may only be used on the right side.
- 2) All rotation tires must be purchased from Raceway Park.
  - a. Visitors should see the Raceway Tire Official for exemption on their first visit.
- 3) You may purchase 8 initial tires. However:
  - a. If you do not race in the first 4 events, you will only be allowed to purchase 6 initial tires.
  - b. If you do not race in the first 6 events, you will only be allowed to purchase 4 initial tires.
- 4) A maximum of 8 tires can be in rotation at any time.
- 5) After your second feature race, you may buy 1 tire each week.
  - a. To purchase a tire, you must have qualified for, and competed in the feature race at your last Raceway regular event.
- 6) All rotation tire serial numbers will be recorded by the Raceway Tire Official.
  - a. It is the responsibility of the driver to see that the tire serial numbers are reported to the Raceway Tire Official. (Electronic scanning may be used.)
  - b. Serial numbers of tires going into, and tires coming out-of rotation, must be reported to the Raceway Tire Official.
- 7) 3 'wild card' tire purchases will be allowed, per racing season, for damaged tires.
  - a. The damaged tire must be shown to the Raceway Tire Official for approval.
  - b. 'Wild card' tire purchases will be pro-rated on the number of feature events you ran.
    - i. 1 tire for the 1<sup>st</sup> 7 events
    - ii. 1 tire for the 2<sup>nd</sup> 7 events
    - iii. 1 tire for the balance of events.
- 8) Special Events: Challenge Series, Double Features, etc.
  - a. Up to 2 new tires may be purchased for these events; however, you may not exceed 8 tires in your rotation. 2 used tires must be used with the 2 new tires.
- 9) Unusual circumstances will be dealt with on a case by case basis.
  - a. The Raceway Tire Official, in consultation with the Promoter, will make the final decision, with explanation, in such cases.
